

(BH) Blackberry Hill Farm, 15 Mud St.

Breads, meats and other local items. Fresh-out-of-the oven wood fired pizza, organic soft Bavarian-style pretzels, pastries, cookies and brownies.

(CM) Candy Mountain, Don Potter Rd.

Shop: maple syrup and pint 'n' pancake mix packages. Follow the "learning line" to see how the sap gets to the sugarhouse and is made into maple syrup.

(CE) Cranewood Estate, 76 Buckley Rd.

A historic farmstead and working sheep ranch. Take a hay-ride and sit by the bonfire with a beverage and take in the views.

(ML) Martin's Lumber, 280 Valley Rd.

Artisan market offers demonstrations and activities plus guided walks for mushrooms and edible plants, (Try dandelion coffee!)

(MS) Mud St. Maple, 269 Mud St.

Everything Maple including bourbon maple syrup. Full maple lunch is available and, new for the fall farm tour – Maple Candy Apples. Kids' activities.

(NM) Nettle Meadow, 484 So. Johnsburg Rd.

Tours on the half hour and cheese samples. Coffee and pumpkin cheese muffins will be served in the morning. Lunch will be offered from noon to 2 p.m.
